Core worker exemption

Employer verification form

When to use this form

This form is for employers, or educational or vocational training institutes, requesting confirmation that an individual holds a core worker exemption.

The Children's Act 2014 <u>outlines a workforce restriction</u> that prevents individuals convicted of specified offenses from being employed or engaged as core children's workers. A core worker exemption lifts this prohibition, allowing an organisation to lawfully employ that person as a core children's worker.

A core worker exemption can only be granted by the Chief Executive of a key agency outlined in the Children's Act. These agencies include:

- Oranga Tamariki—Ministry for Children
- Ministry of Social Development, Te Manatū Whakahiato Ora
- Ministry of Health, Manatū Hauora
- Ministry of Education, Te Tāhuhu o te Mātauranga
- Ministry of Justice, Te Tāhū o te Ture

Organisations are not obligated to employ an individual who holds a core worker exemption. It is still up to the employer to decide whether an individual is suitable for any role they seek to fill.

Submitting this form

This form is in two sections: <u>Section 1: Employer details</u> and <u>Section 2: Details of the individual to be checked</u>. Ensure that both sections are completed.

Required attachments

You must attach a verified copy of identification for the individual to be checked against the core worker exemption register.

Identification may be any one of the following:

- New Zealand Driver Licence
- New Zealand Firearms Licence
- New Zealand Birth Certificate
- New Zealand Passport
- New Zealand Certificate of Identity
- Overseas Passport
- New Zealand Refugee Travel Document

Identification can be current, or expired within the last two years, but cannot be cancelled, defaced or temporary.

What happens next?

Once you have sent us this completed form, we will contact you to confirm that we have received it. We will then inform you in writing of the core worker exemption status of the individual named on this form.
